NEWS

- Delhi HC denied injunction on ANADAY drug of Zuventus Healthcare Ltd use to treat breast cancer while deciding injunction petition presented by Ajanta Pharma who prepare AMADAY drug to treat high blood pressure & heart diseases for export purpose only. Non-availability of AMADAY in local market renders no likelihood of confusion.
- Delhi HC granted injunction against HUL -LifeBuoy (listed as cosmetics) for disparagement of Reckitt Benckiser -Dettol (listed as antiseptic liquid under Drugs & Cosmetics Act).
- *Roslyn Hazlitt v. Apple Inc.* - Facial recognition feature in Apple devices with pre-installed app was accused of collecting and processing biometric data without obliging the consent requirements of Illinois based users which led to class action lawsuit.
- UBio-X Iris - A non-contact biometric iris recognition system has been launched by UnionCommunity which captures iris biometrics at distances up to 50 cm performs rapid identification, and has an auto-tiling function.

- Cyber theft of data in reputed New York City based law firm known to provide legal services to renowned celebrities of media and entertainment industry. Thieves claimed to use **REvil** ransomware, a file blocking virus that infects files through encryption with a message demanding payment in Bit coin.
- Data breach occurred in GoDaddy on October, 2019 which was detected only on April 23, 2020 after some suspicious activity detected on a subset of server. Its impact is under assessment. To cover up the breach company is offering one year of Website Security Deluxe and Express Malware Removal at no cost.
- Australian National University's Cybercrime Observatory reported sale of fake vaccines in dark web alleging to be manufactured using blood of recovered COVID-19 patients and are ripping people of their money.
- CAM4 site mis-configured cloud database has led to leakage of details of users including credit card details, email, chat details etc. exposing users to risk of blackmailing and theft of identity.

## Science & Technology

- Study conducted by University of Cambridge revealed instability in Machine learning and AI in medical image reconstruction which may lead to incorrect outcome. Accuracy and stability are heart and soul of any AI algorithm but when it comes to classification of tiny or invisible change, algorithm may end up wrongly classifying things.
- Queensland University of Technology was able to successfully detect asymptomatic throat cancer during a trial of a new saliva diagnostic through series of saliva HPV tests. This process is still under research stage.
